1st - 6th place Rosettes available in each category.

1st place in each category entitles dog and handler to enter the Best in Show at the end of the Dog Show for a chance to win the Dog Show Trophy.

**Best Puppy** - This event is for puppies under 6 months old. The puppy will be judged on cuteness, confidence and personality.

**Best Rescue** - This event is for all rescue dogs. A brief story will be heard of how they came in to rescue and how they were saved. They will be judged on how well they behave with their owner to show how well they have bonded. Rosettes will go to both dog and owner for being a very special rescuer.

**Golden Oldie** - An event for all the 8+ dogs to show us how its really done! Judged on best behaved OAD (Old Aged Dog).

**Best Young Handler** - For handlers 16 years and under. They are introduced and then start their walk into the middle. The handler with the most control and bond with their dog wins. Any extra tricks can be included.

**Most Handsome Hound** - Event for the boy dogs. No tricks just purely based on looks and uniqueness.

**Most Gorgeous Girl** - Once again judged on looks and uniqueness.

(Not held under The Kennel's Rules and Regulations)

### **RULES:**

- Dogs must have full and up to date inoculations.
- Dogs must not have suffered from or been in contact with any infectious disease during the 6 weeks prior to the Show.
- Dogs do not need to be registered with the Kennel Club and maybe of any breed or variety, except Pit Bull Terriers.
- Any dog left in a car showing signs of distress will be removed forthwith.
- All dogs are exhibited at the owner's risk.
- All competitors are required **to keep dogs on strong leads.**
- Bags and poop scoops will be available and must be used if required. Kindly keep the venue clean and tidy.
- Please do not bring dogs known to fight or bitches in season

The right is reserved to refuse entry of any Dog which, in the opinion of the Organisers, is not in a fit state for exhibition.
